A GUIDE TO CARE FOR Suede

MAINTAINING YOUR FURNITURE

To prevent your suede item from fading or drying out, avoid exposure to direct sunlight for extended periods. Also be sure to keep the product away from water and moisture, as water can leave stains and cause stiffness in the material. Using a suede brush or soft cloth, gently brush off any dirt or dust from the surface of the suede regularly.

TO BE EXPECTED

Suede is esteemed for its matte, soft appearance, making it a popular material for various design projects. Its flexible and breathable nature also contributes to its appeal.

SPOT CLEANING

If your suede product gets wet, gently blot the excess moisture with a clean, dry cloth. Then, allow the item to dry at room temperature. Avoid using heat sources like hair dryers, as they can damage the material.

For wine spills, immediately blot the excess wine with a clean, dry cloth without rubbing. Then, sprinkle a small amount of cornstarch or talcum powder on the stain to absorb the remaining liquid. Let it sit for a few hours or overnight, then brush off the powder and gently clean the stained area with a suede brush.

To take care of oil based stains, sprinkle some baking soda or cornstarch on the affected area and let it sit for a few hours. Then, gently brush off the powder and use a suede eraser or brush to remove any remaining residue. Repeat the process if necessary.

In the case of stubborn stains, try using a suede cleaner specifically designed for suede and carefully follow the listed instructions. In a small space, test the cleaner to ensure compatibility with the product and prevent further damage.

Prevention is key when caring for suede products. Handling spills and stains promptly and correctly helps preserve the quality of your suede items for years to come.
